

The following Policies and Conditions apply to all Patriot Spouses' Club Events.

You must acknowledge and accept the conditions outlined here as a registration condition.

1. The Patriot Spouses' Club now uses our website for all luncheon invitations and registration(s). Please add the Patriot Spouses' Club email to your contact list to ensure you get all and future invitations from us!
2. RSVPs are due one week before the event. Your paid RSVP confirms your seat and meal selection choice(s). Suppose a member misses a luncheon that they RSVP'd "yes" and does not make arrangements to pay by the next Patriot Spouses' Club event. In that case, they are "temporarily suspended from all club events and activities until any past due amounts are satisfied. If the member does not pay, they will not be allowed to join Patriot Spouses' Club again until they are in good standing with the club
3. Lap babies six months and under are welcome to attend. For children older than six months of age, please make other arrangements for their care for the duration of the event.
4. A member may bring a guest(s) to a luncheon or sub-club event once per year if that guest is eligible to be a member of the Patriot Spouses' Club. The member is responsible for their RSVP registration, payment, and meal choice. Guest will need to join the Patriot Spouses Club to attend another luncheon.
5. Event Reservation / Fundraisers: All tickets sold for events are FINAL and cannot be returned or exchanged.
6. Personal belongings should not be left unattended in meeting rooms or public areas. Items left alone are subject to removal by security. Patriot Spouses' Club is not responsible for items left unattended.
7. The Patriot Spouses' Club is committed to providing equal opportunity and treatment to members, attendees, vendors, and community members. At Patriot Spouses' Club luncheons or events, attendees will be respectful to other attendees, volunteers, vendors, and community members. Harassment (includes but is not limited to; unwelcome slurs, jokes, verbal abuse, and sexual harassment) and other misconduct will not be tolerated and could result in removal from the event, future events, and having one's membership revoked.
